ORGAN CORNER

After screening various options for a new organ for First Presbyterian Church, the committee chairman, Peter Witmer, has forwarded requests for proposals from two firms and for three instruments. The anticipated bids should be received by the end of November. At that time the committee will review the proposals and make recommendations to Session for their consideration and decision. Please be aware that once a proposal has been selected the new instrument will not be installed for a minimum of six months to a year. We recognize people might have the opportunity to give before the end of the year and this would be a way in which to do that. To participate all you need to do is:
