ORGAN UPDATE

On Wednesday evening Session approved moving forward in purchasing a new Allen Organ. It is a "Custom Three-Manual, 58-stop Allen Organ with Apex Technology". The work of the organ committee began in June 2017 and has concluded with a recommendation to session last evening. The organ committee has done an incredible job over these years. The members of the committee are: Peter Witmer (chair), Linda Lawrence, Ray Reeder, Donna Burkholder, and our organist/choirmaster Chris Henkel. Make sure you thank them for their work. The Cost Of the organ to install will be \$110,885. Some of you have already contributed generously to the organ fund.
