Thank you for applying for the Community Impact Fund presented by the Strasburg Ministerium! Our hope and prayer is to effectively meet your needs through this program. Here are a few things to keep in mind as you complete the following page:

- The Community Impact Fund is run by a group of volunteers from the various churches within the Strasburg Ministerium. This group is known as the Community Impact Committee (CIC). This program is primarily designed to assist residents of Lancaster County, however, the Community Impact Committee may use their discretion in assisting residents of neighboring counties. Other referrals to supportive programs may be made during the intake process.
- The Community Impact Fund is designed to support individuals and families who are experiencing financial hardship by providing funds for rent, utilities, and emergency needs. Determination will be made by the Community Impact Committee on what constitutes an emergency need.
- We do not require proof of income to apply for funding. However, our committee members may have to ask questions regarding your financial status to assess if further assistance or referrals would be beneficial. We do not share any of the information you provide with anyone outside of the Committee, thereby maintaining confidentiality.
- After filling out the intake form, you will be required to review it with a Community Impact Committee member during a mutually conveniently scheduled appointment. All reasonable accommodations will be made in order for this appointment to take place in a timely manner.
- Please be mindful that filling out this application does not guarantee funding. Your request is also dependent on committee approval and funding available at the time the intake is completed and reviewed.
- If you have further comments, questions, or concerns, please feel free to contact us or leave us a letter in our mailbox (labeled Community Impact Committee at the First Presbyterian Church of Strasburg) with your name and contact information.
