

Join us for a visit of the Co-Moderator of the PCUSA, Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace



Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace was a classmate of Pastor Bob and Stacy at Princeton Theological Seminary. Following seminary they worked together with the Waldensian Church in Italy. She then served as an Associate Pastor at First Presbyterian Church in Bethlehem, PA. She then became Executive Presbyter of San Gabriel Presbytery in Southern California.

Ruth began serving as Executive Presbyter of the Presbytery of Philadelphia in February 2014, making her the first woman and person of color to be installed in their more than 300-year history. She was elected as Co-moderator by the 225th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church, USA in 2022.

Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace also serves on the board of The Presbyterian Foundation and recently completed her term serving on the board of Princeton Theological Seminary.
