Join us for a visit of the Co-Moderator of the PCUSA, Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace



Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace was a classmate of Pastor Bob and Stacy at Princeton Theological Seminary. Following seminary they worked together with the Waldensian Church in Italy.

Ruth is currently serving as Co-Moderator of the 225th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church USA, for which she was elected in 2022.

Ruth currently serves as Executive Presbyter of the Presbytery of Philadelphia, which she began in 2014, making her the first woman and person of color to be installed in their more than 300-year history.

After graduating from Princeton Theological Seminary, she served as Associate Pastor at First Presbyterian Church in Bethlehem, PA. She then became Executive Presbyter of San Gabriel Presbytery in Southern California.

Rev. Ruth Faith Santana-Grace just recently completed her service on two national boards: The Presbyterian Foundation and Princeton Theological Seminary. At Princeton, Ruth was the first woman of color to serve as vice-chair of the board. She is the 2023 recipient of Princeton Theological Seminary's Distinguished Alumnus Award and elected Trustee Emeritus of the seminary.



This praise chorus begins as a paraphrase of Psalm 42:1 and later incorporates parts of Psalm 28:7. In some early Christian communities, people chanted or sang Psalm 42 on their way to be baptized, and many early Christian baptisteries were decorated with deer drinking water.
