He served as the director of Eastern University's Master's of International Development and MBA in Economic Development Programs and most recently finished as Dean of Palmer Theological Seminary in 2021.

David has had many publications, writings and talks that have explored the intersection between business, civil society, faith, and justice, with a particular interest in the area of spiritual metrics, Business as Mission, religion and development, community development and advocacy, evangelical approaches to engaging the development field, and the informing of anthropological theory from a faith-based perspective. David is also cofounder and co-editor of the Christian Relief Development, and Advocacy Journal.
