#### **CURRENT FOOD PANTRY NEEDS**

We continue to need your help in supplying our neighbors in need with items to face any food insecurities that they may be experiencing. You can be a vital part of this ministry by

considering donating any of the following most needed items listed below.

Our food pantry is currently looking for a few volunteers to help us serve our neighbors in need. We are seeking volunteers to help with our weekly shopping of the perishable items which consists of milk, bread and eggs. You would check the stock of those items before we open on Tuesday afternoon and then once again before we open again on Friday afternoon. Purchase any needed items for the week and place them in the refrigerator of the pantry room. We generally distribute anywhere from 15-25 of each item. You would be reimbursed for the costs of the items!

We are also in search of volunteers to help at our pantry desk. We have been extremely busy and could use some extra hands to serve. The pantry is open on Tuesday & Friday afternoons from 2-4pm. You would greet our neighbor in need, check them in and provide any assistance they may need while they choose their items. There are always two volunteers covering the desk. You choose a day that fits your schedule for a 2 hour shift.

This year FPS will again participate in the Santa's Helpers Program by having interested members of the congregation purchase a specific gift for a child in need. The Santa's Helpers program began over 30 years ago when the founders discovered a family that could not afford to buy Christmas gifts nor a Christmas meal for their family. The program has grown into a non-profit organization which partners with the L-S School District to provide Christmas for over 100 needy families. Our congregation joined this effort in 2011 and has purchased over 1,000 toys for children of needy families in our area since our participation began. To play a part in this valuable program all you need to do is:

Sign-up to purchase a gift at the giving tree located next to the receptionist desk on either Sunday, November 30 or Sunday, December 7.

You sign-up by picking a tag from the tree, which will include the number of a child along with the specific gift.

Your name and the number of your child will be registered by a volunteer at the sign-up table.

Please spend between \$15 to \$20 for the gift.
Gifts do not need to be wrapped; all wrapping will be done by the Santa's Helpers organization.
